

Catch Up Analysis, Review and Action September 2018

Year 7 (2017/18)

203 on roll.

82 are eligible for catch up

35 students are PP: 16 girls and 19 boys

26 students are SEND: 11 girls are also SEND, 15 boys are also SEND

15 students are PP and not SEND

40 students are not PP or SEND

Strengths:

- PP students are making greater progress than non PP with boys out-performing the girls
- Half of the catch up cohort have made progress
- PP students are making better progress than SEND

Area for focus:

- Despite progress being made by half of the cohort there are still 45 students with a reading age below 10:0. These students need to be highlighted and tracked in Year 8 with targeted intervention put in place.
- SHU and HJ will liaise with Maths and English staff about teaching of the low attaining two groups in September 2018
- SHU to deploy TA support towards these students from September
- 24% of the cohort have either left or are accessing alternative provision. We will give support to those in the AP from September as with the rest of the cohort.
