<p><b>Art and Design GCSE</b></p> <p>Fine Art <i>OR</i> Graphic Communication</p> <p>Taught by</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mr S Moore</li> <li>• Mrs C Whittingham</li> </ul> 	<p>Coursework 60% (September 2017 - December 2018)</p> <p>At the end of the course, students will present a portfolio of work, which consists of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One coursework project which shows how a student has developed their artwork thoroughly from a starting point through to a final conclusion.</li> <li>• The process includes working to a project brief, researching, developing ideas, experimentation and producing a final piece.</li> <li>• A variety of other supporting artwork done over the two years that provides additional evidence towards the four assessment objectives.</li> </ul> <p>Examination 40% (January 2019 - April 2019)</p> <p>At the end of the course, students will present an examination project, which consists of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A project or body of artwork developed from a choice of starting points set by the examination board.</li> <li>• The process includes planning a project brief, researching, developing ideas, experimentation and producing a final piece.</li> <li>• The test/final piece includes students having to work by themselves, over a set period of time (10 hours), under examination conditions.</li> </ul>	<p>In the GCSE Art and Design course you will have the opportunity to study in a variety of areas including Drawing and Painting, Mixed Media, Graphic Design, Digital Art, Three Dimensional Studies and Printmaking. We like to cover a broad range of media, materials and techniques during the course so that students have a good grounding in a variety of processes to help them make decisions about what they may like to pursue in the future.</p> <p>At the beginning of the course the work is guided to ensure students understand how to meet all the assessment objectives in full. However as you become more confident and independent you will have the chance to develop your work in a more personal way.
